For children who first access funded hours in the Summer term (i.e. they are born between 1 January to 31 March), monthly rates during their first term with funding may be slightly higher than the average calculation shown above due to the higher number of unfunded weeks in the Summer.

## Monthly Rates

Your weekly charge is multiplied by the 51 weeks we are open and spread equally over 12 months.



### Our fees include the following as standard:

1. Montessori style of teaching and learning
2. Breakfast, Mid-morning snacks, Lunch and Afternoon tea
3. Weekly Forest school sessions during term time
4. Baking once a week (38 weeks)
5. Wipes
6. Free lending library for all children with books, story sacks, games and puzzles.
7. Organised outings (*frequency varies*)
8. Access to outdoor play and learning all year round
9. Extra-curriculum – STEM Workshop, Animal handling workshop, Circuit sessions
10. Graduation ceremony for preschool children

We are pleased to offer the government's 15 hours and 30 hours funding schemes. Please refer to Funding Policy for details. We also accept Tax Free Childcare.



- We offer a sibling discount of 5% on the elder sibling's invoice.
- Our non-funded daily rates are discounted
- Discounted non funded hourly rate applies depending on attendance. *See table below*

- Our fees are calculated based on a combination of funded weeks and non-funded weeks. A wrap around cost is applied which comprises of hourly rate for non-funded hours plus non mandatory essential extras charge per week (depending on funded hours). Government funding is for 38 weeks and the nursery is open and charge for 51 weeks in a year. (*See Funding policy*)

- Government Funding - Early Years Funding is intended to cover the delivery of childcare only. It does not cover the cost of meals and snacks, non-food consumables, or additional hours. To cover costs not included in the Early Years Funding we request parents pay a non-mandatory Essentials and Extras fee for every funded hour booked. (See *Funding Policy*)
- Meals Policy - We are committed to providing nutritious and delicious meals prepared on site for all children, regardless of dietary needs. Allergies and food intolerances are taken very seriously, and it's important that everyone follows our Meals Policy to help keep all children safe. If you have any questions or concerns, please speak to the Nursery Manager
- The nursery is closed for public holidays, for 3 days over Christmas and for 2 inset days each year. Our fees account for these closures, so no refund is applied; places are offered in accordance with our Admission Policy. *Also see funding agreement*
- Securing your child's place - Once you are offered a space you are required to pay a £90 fee which covers your time from admission till all agreed settling sessions.
- Fees are payable in advance on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month. Fees received after this date may incur a late payment charge.
- We accept payment by BACs, Standing Order, Tax-Free Childcare or Childcare Vouchers;
- Fees are subject to review in accordance with our Terms and Conditions.
- All food is freshly prepared daily on site by our dedicated cook to cater for all children's dietary requirements
- Termination and change of sessions - We require a one month's notice by email for children leaving or for change of sessions
